## NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$.6700 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of <u>Crosby</u> County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE

\$ <u>0.670000</u> per \$100

NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$ 0.681975 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$ 0.807724 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the <u>2021</u> tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for <u>Crosby County</u> from the same properties in both the <u>2020</u> tax year and the <u>2021</u> tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that <u>Crosby County</u> may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that <u>Crosby County</u> is not proposing to increase property taxes for the <u>2021</u> tax year. A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON <u>Monday</u>, <u>September 13<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2021 at 10:15 a.m. at the Crosby County Courthouse</u>, <u>2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Courtroom</u>.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, <u>Crosby County</u> is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Commissioners Court of Crosby County by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
